



Prevention Committee Report

Tributary 1:

Force Construction started the new rock sediment barrier wall in Tributary 1 in late September (as designed by Burke Engineering) (to be completed within 90 days). Construction road signs are posted before the entrance at 750 and on Poplar and West Grandview Drives. Be aware of large trucks and equipment in this area.

Adam Engelau will be submitting a bid to dredge the rest of the pond this fall (pending weather and the pond drying up). Force Construction will give Adam access to the area. Land Use Committee will oversee the replacement of the foot bridge in the spring.

Tributary 2:

Adam Engelau has been contracted to clean out behind Tributary 2 and replace the trash rack (as soon as weather permits). Additionally, we will have him repair some of the work left by the County Highway Department when they pulled their large earth moving equipment off location which will include grading and seeding on both sides of the road. Additionally, rip-rap will be replaced at the bottom of the culvert pipe (lake side).

Other Sites to Be Addressed:

The Prevention Committee made site visits to other areas of concern on the woods side for our water quality in late September and Adam Engelau is preparing quotes for each of these sites; the goal to completed by year-end (again pending weather conditions)

- Small tributary behind Lot 61A – culvert and trash rack on woods side needs cleaned out. County Highway Department has been contacted to dredge the ditch along the road in this area.
- Tributary 5 behind Lot 93 – deep ravine on woods side, with 2 small creeks converging into culvert pipe, needs new trash rack (strong silt fence) installed before the water enters culvert pipe.
- Small tributary behind Lot 158-160 – Trash rack needs cleaned out. County Highway Department notified that culvert pipe is corroded through at the entrance on woods side.
- Lawson Hill Farm Drive – Culvert needs cleaned out and gravel and brush on trail behind walking bridge needs cleaned out

We will compile estimate of costs to repair these sites after we receive Adam Engelau's quotes

Thanks to all lot owners for your patience and support of these projects. There is a map at the GLOA office that shows all the sites.

GRANDVIEW WOODS HIKING TRAIL

Included in this article is information regarding the hiking trail and trail heads, this year's scheduled Fall Hike, and the 2018 Deer Hunt.

TAKE A HIKE! Hunting will not be allowed in our woods during the month of October. It's a perfect time to "take a hike". Below are some tips to access and enjoy the trail which encompasses the whole lake through the woods and across the dam.

1. Start at any of the marked Trail Heads or access point for a 6-mile hike around the lake or go from Trail Head to Trail Head or access point.
2. Once on the trail look for Blue Blazes on the trees along the trail. These will help you stay on the trail.
3. Watch for the mile markers on posts along the trail.
4. The trail is hilly. Wear sturdy shoes.
5. Trail maps are available in the GLOA office and include a list of the locations of the Trail Heads and access points.

Access Points to Grandview Woods Hiking Trail

Trail Heads with Maps

1. Across from Pond Road—North side of lake
2. Across from Lot 278—North side of lake
3. Access at Lawson Hill Road/Locust Lane—No map
4. Across from Lot 135 at Tributary II—North side of lake
5. Road 750W—North side of sediment pond, both sides of road
6. Access across from Lot 054. Short distance into woods to trail. Map at Trail Head—West side of lake
7. Poplar Drive across from Lot 019T. Next to power line easement—West side of lake
8. Bellsville Pike across from entrance to Poplar Drive—South side of lake
9. Across from South end of dam

A fall hike is scheduled for October 20, 2018. *In October there will be no deer hunting in the woods.* Meet at the GLOA office at 10:00 a.m. A driver will be available at 750W to take hikers to the office or to their homes if they choose not to continue the hike. Please bring a snack if you would like.

As the weather begins to cool the Land Use Committee encourages lot owners and their guests to hike the trails in our beautiful woods

Deer Hunt in the Grandview Woods

- **Bow hunting** begins in the wood on Thursday, November 1st and continues on weekdays until Friday, November 16th with the exception of one (1) Saturday, November 3rd. No hunting on any Sunday or on Saturday, November 10th.
- **Gun season hunting** begins on Saturday, November 17th and the woods are closed to all hiking that day PLUS Monday November 19th through Wednesday, November 21st and Monday November 26th through Friday, November 30th.
- Weekends including Thanksgiving Day and the day after, there will be no hunting.
- There will be NO HUNTING at all from December 1st to December 7th. During that time the woods are open to hiking.
- Woods are closed again on Saturday, December 8th for the start of **Muzzle Loading gun and Late Archery hunting** and will be closed from Monday, December 10th through Friday, December 14th and from Monday, December 17th to Friday, December 21st. Weekends during that period will be open to hiking.
- The woods will be closed for the last day on Saturday, December 22nd.
- This information will be posted on the signs at each Trail head.
