GLOA WEBSITE

Over the past few weeks we have had some issues with the website. After working with our website support, additional security features have been added to the site.

The website is back up; however, **all lot owners that had previously registered on the site will need to re-register.** You will need to create a new username, and the last portion must be the lot owner's last name followed by their lot number (no spaces). For instance, John Doe who owns lot number 599a must have the following as the last portion of his username: Doe599a. You can put anything you like before the last name.

Once you register you will be put into a "pending" status until approved by the GLOA office. After approved you should receive an email with instructions on completing the registration.

All users were deleted in order to not only restore the website, but also to add the new security features.

GATE AT LAUNCH/GLOA OFFICE AREA

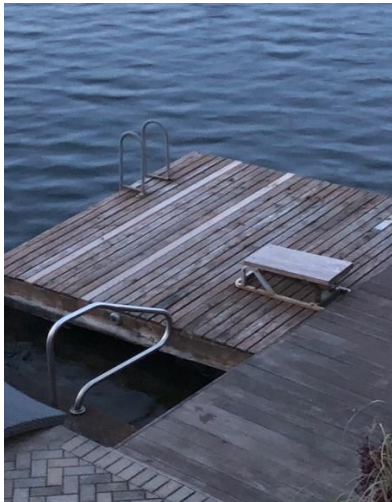
Reminder to always lock the gate when coming and going after office hours and on weekends.
