I would like to give you a short update on the Dredging Project.

We have Individual Lot Action Plans for every lot in the dredging area. We have waivers from everyone that wants to clean up closer than 5 feet from shoreline and fixed docks. That limits the liability to GLOA for any damage, but also gets us the best quality dredge process.

Approximately 20 lot owners are having their lifts removed the week after Thanksgiving. All lots and lifts will be marked for proper disposition and action.

The dredge operations will begin the first week of January. They will work during light hours. Two lot owners have very graciously offered their lots for silt exit sites. This is no small sacrifice as we will have many trucks running from the lake to the disposal site. The Lienhoop's and Robb Bonebrake have agreed to allow us to use their lots as exit sites. Without them this project becomes considerably more expensive as few lots have adequate truck access.

We will use the area behind the Waste Water Treatment plant (the old lagoon) as the disposal site. We plan on completing the job by April 15.

As this is the time for thanksgiving, I really want to thank the folks that have made this effort possible. Engineering support: Harold Force, Ken Rogoski, Matt Bartlett, and Gary Gossett. Shoreline prep work: Jeff and Barbara Braun, Phil Bush, and Gary Gossett. And finally, Beth Ann, who really coordinates **ALL** the activities! They have done most of the work!

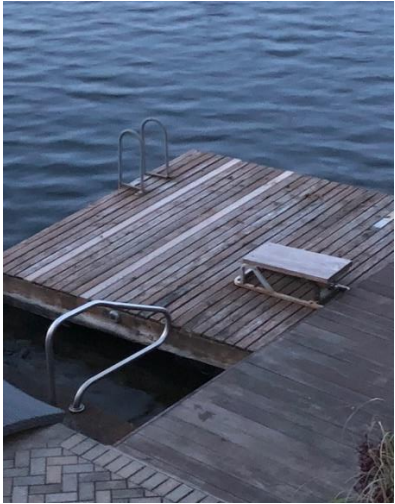
The canoe at right washed up during the recent wind storm on the dock at Lot 181. There are no lot numbers on the canoe. If this is yours it is at Lot 181.
