Lift Removal

The team of Bush, Braun, Gossett and Reindl have marked each lift and seadoo port that was to be removed. We have engaged Deaton's Waterfront Services to bring in a barge with a small crane/hoist mounted on it to pull the lifts.

Deaton's has done a great job of removing all 21 lifts. The lifts were "stuck" in mud and silt, but all came out eventually. A Grandview team member was present for **each** removal.

Some lifts were pretty old with rusty bolts or missing pads and need to be repaired before they go back in. Deaton's is making a list of the required repairs for the lot owners to evaluate and either agree to or get someone else to repair **BEFORE** the April put back time. They will be following up also with lot owners for payment.

Phil's lot has his two lifts plus two additional lifts stored there. Thanks Phil!

Pre-Dredge work

A pre-dredge meeting was held on December 5th with the Grandview team, SRS and Adam Engelau. Specific Lot Plans, Exit site prep and disposal site prep was discussed.

Phil and Jeff have purchased lot signs and labeled **EACH** lot in the target area so that SRS can identify each lot from the water. A book with each Lot Plan was reviewed with SRS and will be given to the dredge operator to make sure that each lot owner's requests are known by the dredger.

Jeff and Barbara Braun, Phil Bush and Gary Gossett have been terrific and have worked many hours to get us to where we are today. I think we are positioned well for a successful dredge project.
