DREDGING UPDATE FROM FRANK REINDL

I wanted to keep you abreast of the progress on the project. If you remember, we will be using an excavator mounted on a barge that will dig the silt from the lake bottom and put it into a hopper on the barge. The barge will be moved to the shoreline at the exit site where it will be loaded to trucks to be hauled to the disposal site behind the waste water treatment plant. We have changed the exit site lot that we will be using for removing the silt from the barges to the trucks. That lot is now the Pippen's, Lot 132.

This past Monday we started to prepare that lot for the process. If you have seen some activity there, it is because we have started putting in the access path from the lake to the road. We thank the Pippen's for generously giving us the use of their lot.

The boat lifts are out, the exit site and the disposal site are being prepared for production to start shortly after Jan 1. We will keep you updated on the progress being made as we move into the new year.
