DREDGING

The Grandview Lot Owners Association periodically conducts a bathymetric survey of the lake to determine if there are areas that need to be dredged to maintain the water quality and depth of the lake, particularly in the coves with major tributaries feeding the lake. The results of this year's survey will be compared to the previous survey to determine what action will be needed in the future.

In the meantime, there are several lot owners that want to have the area in front of their lot dredged for a variety of reasons. This work is being done with the individual lot owners bearing the cost. Following are activities that are coming up on the 4th of July weekend.




CONCERT ON THE DAM Sunday, July 2nd 6:00-9:00
