### WEED CONTROL SIGN UP

Email or call the GLOA office at 812-342-1219 to sign up. <u>Deadline</u> for signup is Monday June 12th.

<u>Information needed:</u> Your name, billing address, lot number, phone number and LENGTH of shoreline.

Treatment will extend out 100 feet from the shore. Cost is \$4.00 per linear foot of shoreline. Aquatic Control will handle billing. Treatment is scheduled for Wednesday, June 21st.

1-day swimming restriction in treated areas only, no irrigation restriction. Other water use restrictions include:

- Livestock/domestic animal watering- 1 day
- Turf irrigation 3 days
- Food crop irrigation 5 days
- Drinking water- 3 days

#### **LAKE SAFETY**

Let's start off the safety news with a classic literary poem: Roses are red, violets are blue, some people still don't know the lake safety rules, do you?

- **1. SIZE DOESN'T MATTER:** Only two humans allowed behind the boat, (Skiers, tubers, etc..), on weekends from 12pm to 6pm. It does not matter if the riders are little children or full-size adults. Remember, a PWC must have enough seating for the driver/observer and those towed behind the PWC.
- **2. SPEED:** The speed limit on the lake is 35MPH during the day and Idle speed/NO WAKE after sunset every day, 365 days a year.
- **3. PLOWING:** The period of not being on plane and above the speed of idle. This action creates a huge wake. Either plane off or slow down to make smaller wakes.
- **4. RECKLESS DRIVING:** Endangering fellow riders or other boaters/swimmers on the lake; No 360's, extensive zig/zag patterns, or spraying objects or people with PWC's.
- **5. IDLE ZONES:** No wake in idle zones, please stop wake action prior to entering.
- **6. BOAT STICKERS: MANDATORY** powered boats/PWCs must have visible stickers on both sides of the boat prior to operating in/on the lake.
- **7. AGE:** Any boat or PWC over 10HP must be operated by someone that is at least 16yrs old or accompanied by someone 16yrs old or older No younger; verification may be requested.
- **8. BOAT DRIVING LESSONS:** Contact the office if boat driving lessons are desired.
- 9. STAY SAFE! ENJOY THE LAKE.


