## LAKE SAFETY

What causes some boats to become party boats? Pier Pressure 😊

Summer is officially here, and it is going fast. At least it seems like it, school is just around the corner.

The lot owners and Board members want the lake to be fun, yet safe. If guests are coming to visit this weekend, please let them know the lake rules, especially the common safety related items.

Here are reminders about some of the key safety items.

1. Do not swim more than 100ft from shore and do not cross congested boat lanes or cross coves-even in no wake zones. It is **EXTREMELY** hard to see swimmers and if you can believe it, some people may not pay attention to where they are going!
2. **Observers are required** on weekends or Fridays before holiday weekends after 10AM.
3. **TURN BOAT LIGHTS ON AT THE DESIGNATED SUNSET TIME.**  
Numerous boats have been observed without any lights on at dusk and after. Don't assume your boat is visible.
4. 360's on boats or PWC's is prohibited, especially while pulling tubers or skiers.
5. **Please ensure stickers are visible and updated.**
6. **Lightning**-If there is severe weather or lightning observed around the lake-**GET OFF THE WATER.**
7. Passing other boats-**Pass other boats on the Left**, not on the right between the other boat and shore. Also, try to stay at least 100ft from other boats when passing, spacing is key. If you cannot maintain spacing, either stop, change course or slow down.
8. **Fireworks**: Stay a minimum of 100ft from the dam during the fireworks show, falling debris may be hot, it could burn you or your boat.
9. **Wake surfing**-Please stay in the designated wake surfing area on the lake.
