



**Lake Safety-Labor Day Weekend**

**Thank you for an overall safe summer. Be safe this weekend!!**

**1. Please use common sense this weekend.**

- a. Take a moment to review lake safety rules and remember to inform guests about lake safety-you are responsible for their actions. Most of the violations are from guests of lot owners.
  - b. Remember all power boats, including jet skis following or overtaking another boat shall stay clear of any boat ahead by at least 100 ft. and shall overtake or pass to the left no closer than 50 ft. from the other boat. If either or both boats are pulling skiers, tubers, or persons, the 100 ft. minimum clearance includes the skiers, tubers, or persons, and equipment. No boat shall be operated so as to directly follow the path of a skier, tuber or person at any distance of less than 300 ft.
  - c. On weekends a boat may **tow no more than two (2) of the following:** skiers, tubers or persons at any one time from noon to 8:00 p.m., and on holidays a boat may tow no more than two of the following: skiers, tubers, or persons at any one time from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. A tow rope shall not be longer than 80 ft. and must not be allowed to trail behind a boat when the boat is not pulling a skier, tuber or person.
2. A drowning can happen quickly, and usually silently. Avoid alcohol while supervising children and before or during swimming, boating, or waterskiing.
  3. **Lake Direction:** Please follow the assigned direction of flow on the lake, which is counter-clockwise if looking at the lake from above.

4. **Reminder: Stay 100 ft away from shore in your boats. Stay within 100 ft of shore if swimming/paddle boarding, etc. Stay 300 ft from shore when wake surfing. Do not operate faster than slow IDLE after dark, and by all means, do not speed through the designated no wake/idle zones.**
5. Finally, have enough life jackets in your boat for all occupants and wear life jackets while driving/riding PWC's.
