ALGAE BLOOMS

After reports of algae blooms, we had Aquatic Control take samples to conduct testing of the algae. Tests confirm the algae is not toxic, but out of an abundance of precaution, it is recommended pets not drink water from areas where algae is present. While the algae is dissipating, we will continue to monitor the water quality.

INVASIVE MANAGEMENT

Habitat solutions will be starting invasive management in our forest on track two (which is from 750 W to Bellsville Pike) this month. They will be cutting large autumn olive and then stump treatment. If you have any questions, please contact Todd at the lake office.
