While on land, beavers and muskrats are easy to tell apart, but it can be easy to confuse the two when they're spotted in the water. You can usually see a muskrat's whole body when it is swimming; however, you often can only see a beaver's large wedge-shaped heads while they swim. Beavers eat tree bark and chew down trees; muskrats eat grasses, vegetation and rubber around boats, wiring, etc. There have been a couple of reported beaver sightings and damage this week.
